Supported alternative energy solutions.

Randy has supported projects investing in alternative energy solutions to reduce our nation's dependence on oil and to increase fuel efficiency of our vehicles.

Opposed the cap-and-trade energy tax bill.

Randy voted against legislation that would increase energy bills per household by \$1,200 per year, cost between 1.8 and 7 million net jobs, and send industrial and manufacturing jobs overseas.
