RANDY FORBES IS WORKING TO LEAVE THEM WITH A BETTER AMERICA.

UPHOLDING THE 10TH AMENDMENT. *"The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people."* To ensure that the Tenth Amendment is upheld, Congressman Forbes cosponsored a simple but powerful resolution that reaffirms Congress' commitment to the 10th Amendment to the United States Constitution.

CUTTING GOVERNMENT SPENDING BY 40%. Congressman Forbes has introduced the Tighten Washington's Belt Act, which would cut federal government discretionary spending by 40% over the next five years. It would establish spending limits, and if Congress breaches those spending limits, an automatic across-the-board spending cut from all discretionary programs would be enacted to keep federal spending within its limits. In addition, Congressman Forbes supports mandating a 2/3 roll call vote in both the House and Senate chambers in order to raise the debt ceiling.

PRESERVING THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE. Congressman Forbes has a copy of the Declaration of Independence hanging in his office in Washington to serve as a reminder that the set of rights that the document established are innate within individuals, given to individuals by a Creator, and that the government cannot take those rights from anyone.

CALLING FOR FISCALLY RESPONSIBLE, ACCOUNTABLE AND TRANSPARENT GOVERNMENT. Congressman Forbes was one of 17 out of 435 Members of Congress to vote against all stimulus and bailout packages under both Presidents Bush and Obama. He has introduced the Congressional Accountability Pay (CAP) Act to tie Member of Congress' salaries to the growth in federal spending - the more they spend, the less they make. In addition, he has called for bills to be posted online at least 72 hours for the public to review before a vote, to give Americans access to the cost and impact of legislation.

REFUSING TO APOLOGIZE FOR AMERICA. Congressman Forbes believes that America is exceptional and has called her the standard for the entire world to look to. He believes that if individuals want mediocrity, it can be found in other parts of the world, but it does not belong in the United States of America.
