# We need *lasting* solutions in healthcare.

Congressman Forbes has a plan for a **better way forward.**

### **Expand Access and Affordability of Coverage**

Congressman Forbes has worked to make it easier for individuals to obtain and keep health insurance, and allow those who like their current coverage to keep it. He has cosponsored legislation to provide refundable tax credits for low-income Americans to select their medical coverage, and allows churches, associations, and other civic groups to set up new insurance pools and offer affordable health care to their members. It would further reduce healthcare costs for high-risk individuals, such as those with pre-existing conditions, by increasing support for high-risk insurance pools and reinsurance mechanisms.

### **Create Association Health Plans for Small Businesses**

Congressman Forbes supports creating Association Health Plans to allow more small businesses to join together and negotiate with insurance companies on a level playing field, just like large businesses already do.

### **Protect Consumers from Health Insurance Termination**

Congressman Forbes introduced a bipartisan bill that would protect consumers from health insurance cancellation resulting from one missed payment, often due to hospitalization or postal office error.

### **End Medical Malpractice Abuse**

Congressman Forbes supports implementing commonsense reforms to our medical malpractice liability system by reducing frivolous lawsuits.

### **Revolutionize New Cures for Diseases by Doubling Medical Research**

Congressman Forbes introduced a bill that would direct new funding to the National Institutes of Health (NIH) to those research projects that have the most clinical benefit for patients in the near-term.
