- Made the streets of America safer by increasing penalties for violent crime and funding law enforcement technologies and techniques to prosecute violent criminals associated with street gangs.
- Helped protect senior citizens from identity thieves who are on the hunt for seniors' personal and private information, by hosting various Identity Theft Workshops each year.
- Supports providing the FBI with authority to assist state and local law enforcement when states or local governments request help in investigating mass killings, like the shootings at Virginia Tech.
- Supports directing the Department of Justice to establish a program to consider, in consultation with state and local governments, the need to recruit, assign and retain federal law enforcement officers in jurisdictions with high rates of homicide or other violent crimes.
- Introduced legislation to prevent the transfer of detainees from Guantanamo Bay to Virginia communities.
- Urged the Department of Justice to enforce federal obscenity laws, to curb the production and distribution of pornography. Cosponsored legislation that would aid law enforcement in investigating online child pornography cases and would create a new federal offense for the knowing financial facilitation of child pornography.
