Preserving the Constitutional Right to Bear Arms

Consistently seeking to defend Second Amendment Constitutional rights. Randy signed an amicus curiae brief in support of second amendment rights for the case of McDonald v. The City of Chicago, which deals with the important constitutional issue of whether the Second Amendment applies to state and local governments through the Fourteenth Amendment.

Received an "A" rating from the National Rifle Association for his commitment to the protection of Second Amendment rights. In addition, he is a member of the **Congressional Sportsmen's Caucus**, which is the sportsmen's primary ally in Washington promoting and protecting the rights of hunters, trappers and anglers.

Fought for the right to conceal and carry. Randy cosponsored legislation to provide a national standard by which nonresidents of a state may carry concealed firearms in the state.

Protected the right of retired officers conceal and carry. Randy introduced legislation to make it easier for retired law enforcement officers to carry concealed weapons.

Protected U.S. sovereignty and Second Amendment rights from U.N. interference. Randy is cosponsoring legislation to cut off all funding to the United Nations if the U.S. agrees to any treaty that would "restrict, attempt to restrict, or otherwise adversely infringe on the rights of individuals in the United States to possess a firearm or ammunition, including by imposing burdens on international commerce, or abridge any of the other constitutionally protected rights of citizens of the United States."

Reformed the ATF's penalty system. Randy worked to reform the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (BATFE) by cosponsoring H.R.1093, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives Reform Act of 2011.

Support the expansion of the right to carry on federal land. Randy voted to support gun owners' rights to possess guns in National Parks.
