- ★ **Lost your DD214?** To obtain a replacement DD214 (or if you were never issued one), visit [www.archives.gov](http://www.archives.gov) or <http://forbes.house.gov/constituentservices/casework> to download the SF180 and a privacy authorization form. Complete and send to our Chesapeake or Chesterfield office.
- ★ **Are you eligible to receive care from a private doctor?** Find out at [www.va.gov/opa/choiceact/](http://www.va.gov/opa/choiceact/) or call 1-866-606-8198. If the VA can't provide eligible veterans with timely medical care, you're able to seek care from non-VA facilities.
- ★ **Have questions about your VA benefits?** Contact the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs at 1-800-827-1000, or the Virginia Department of Veteran Services' Richmond Headquarters at (804) 786-0286.

**Can we help?** Due to the large number of veterans and their families in the 4th District, my district staff devotes significant time to helping them navigate the bureaucracy of the DOD, Veterans Affairs, and National Personnel Records Center, assisting families in obtaining certified documents for burial purposes, helping veterans apply for health benefits, and more. **It's an honor we take seriously.**
